Typical acceptable materials include:

- home, lawn and garden chemicals used for pest, insect and weed control

- lamp and heating oil
- corrosives such as muriatic acid, and oven or drain cleaners with lye
- swimming pool additives
- photo chemicals
- thermometers, thermostats, and barometers containing mercury
- oil based paint, varnish, stains, polyurethane
